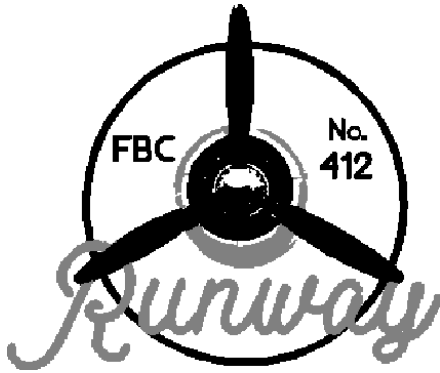


Runway Student Ministries



Student Leadership

Our student ministry puts a high priority on student leadership. We are asking students to raise the bar and live by a high moral standard and lead our ministry. This body of students is in charge of helping to plan our yearly calendar, casting the vision of our ministry and putting in the time and hard work necessary to make Runway Student Ministry the best it can be. We offer leadership training through events and bible studies with the intention of helping our students become the leaders God has called them to be.

Student Leadership is open to current 7-12 grade students who are willing to be held to a higher standard and must meet all the following criteria that has been set by our students, student's parents, youth workers, and other church leadership. This form must be turned in by February 27th to be eligible for the 2019 Leadership Team.

Student Leadership Criteria

A leadership student is a student who...

- Has made a commitment to follow Christ
- Has an active devotional life
- Regularly attends and supports our student ministry and their home church
 - Regularly Attends = Attending **AT LEAST** 51% of scheduled church programs each month which include: Sunday School, Sunday Morning Worship, Sunday Night Bible Studies, Noonday and our Student Midweek Bible Study.
- Is an active leader in RUNWAY Student Ministry.
- Has a positive witness/testimony outside our church.
- Expresses a willingness to share their faith with their peers and others.
- Is involved in a growing & maturing discipleship process by participating in our Discipleship Program or another qualified discipleship process.

Students who continue to meet the above listed criteria are able to participate in events planned to further leadership development and utilize their gifts to share their faith and God's love. These events include but aren't limited to:

Student Ministry Event Planning (Monthly beginning in March)
Super Summer – Student Leadership Development Camp (June 10-14, 2019)
Fall Leadership Retreat (August 31, 2019)
